We were unfortunately not too impressed with the DJ service that comes with the wedding package they offer, so if you are considering having your wedding here, we would recommend hiring your own professional DJ and just use the equipment provided as part of the package (if thats possible). Many of the songs were not mixed into each other seamlessly (i.e. there was full fade out before the next song started, volume was up and down, etc) as you would expect from a pro, and despite the DJ having a list of songs we specified, he still played many radio hits from his own list (I had to request that he play our songs at times). We also brought our own iPod with to play music during dinner, but there were issues get it working with the PA system so we suggest testing everything beforehand and not assuming everything will just work on the day. Sergio really impressed me by sorting the issue out within minutes though. He has a laser vision for detail and also spotted a mistake on our dinner menus (our fault), which again, he took initiative to correct by adjusting the food to be served on the day!! That is really going beyond the call of duty - Thank you Sergio!

We also had a beer keg outside which went down a treat, and ice lollies to cool down guests from the heat ;-). Inside is well air-conditioned and very comfortable. We imported our own flowers, and they were arranged by YC staff - we thought they did a very good job (bear in mind that locally supplied flowers are from the island so variety is limited, so you might want to consider importing flowers which is what we did - it didn't cost that much extra).

All in all, we would HIGHLY recommend having your wedding here. I can only comment on what I noticed, which is obviously only the tip of the iceberg - there is so much more that happens behind the scenes that the team at the Yacht Club make happen so wonderfully.
